You can register online to take the SAT and/or ACT. No one does this for you; you must register yourself. Almost all colleges/universities accept either the SAT or ACT or will take your higher score if you take both. You must pay with credit card, check/money order, or **fee waiver**. See a high school counselor to see if you qualify for a **fee waiver**. Most students take a test during spring of the junior year and/or fall of the senior year. **Remember to register for the test(s) on time! Otherwise, you are subject to late fees and/or standby/waitlist fees. If you miss late deadlines and also miss ACT standby deadline or SAT waitlist deadline, you will NOT get a spot. No "day-of, walk-in" testing permitted.**
